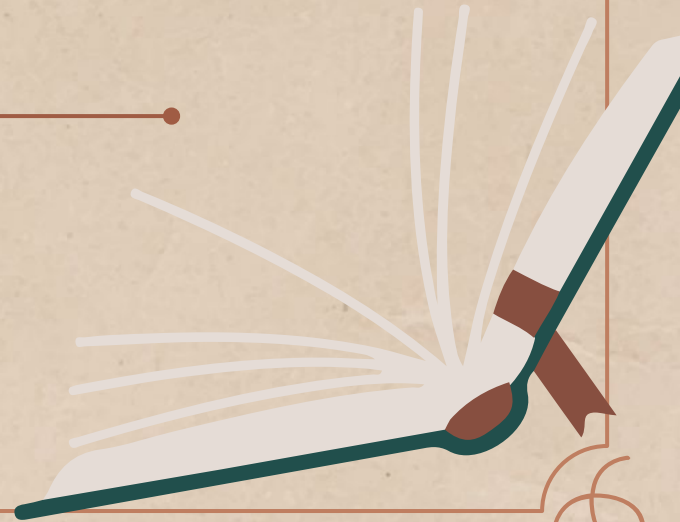
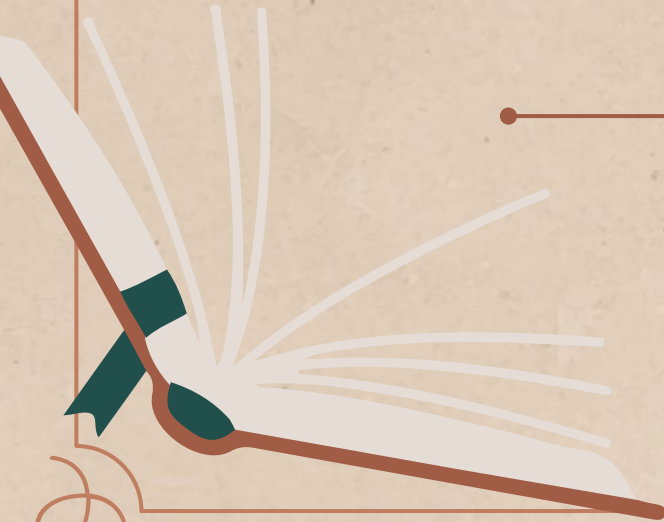

James Augustine Aloysius Joyce (2 February 1882 – 13 January 1941) was an **Irish novelist**, short story writer, poet and literary critic. He contributed to the modernist avant-garde movement and is regarded as one of the **most influential and important writers** of the 20th century.

Joyce in Italy



Italo Svevo and James Joyce met in Trieste in 1906 and a close friendship was born between them. The friendship between Svevo and Joyce arose from completely random circumstances. In fact Joyce, in exile from his Ireland, taught English in Trieste, and Svevo took lessons from him. Those lessons soon turned into literary discussions. It was probably thanks to Joyce's encouragement that Svevo completed "La coscienza di Zeno" which made him a known and respected figure in European culture.
