From May 8th to May 15th
2022



Sunday 8th May - Arrival day

We left on May 8, 2022, 12 students and two teachers.

We met at 7:40 in the Market Square and all together we took a shuttle to the airport of Ancona, from where we took the flight to Krakow and then, by bus, we arrived at our hotel in Krasnik where the Polish teacher welcomed us with her students.

We spent the evening together with the students coming from the other partner countries.

Monday 9th May - First day

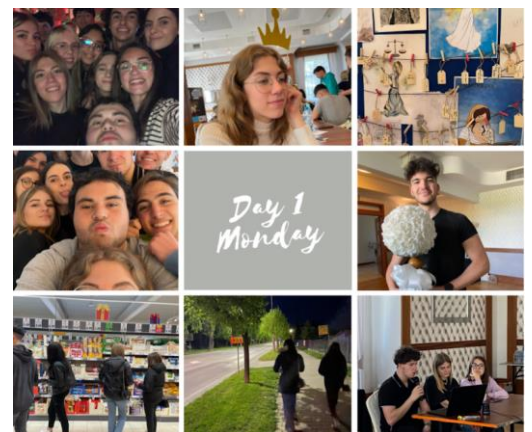
We spent all day in the conference room of the hotel working on the various planned activities on female writers. We presented our works and then we did some workshops related to female writers/characters.

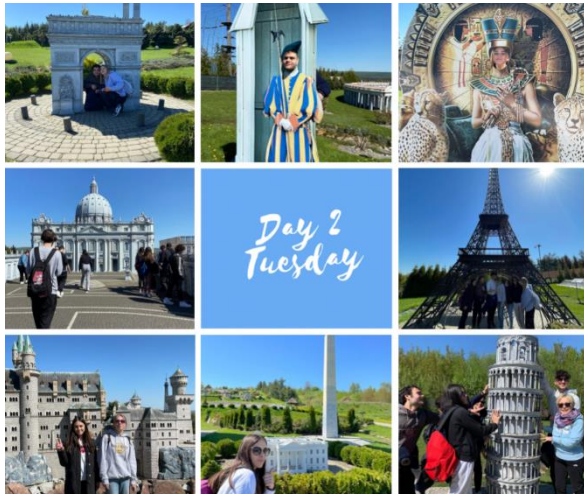
After that we we all danced together getting to know each other.

Tuesday 10th May - Second Day

We went to a Miniature Park where we saw the most important attractions from all over the world. We had lunch in a large shopping center where we had the chance to eat typical food.





In the afternoon we went to the Jaskinia Raj, a system of caves where we enjoyed a guided tour. Then a bus took us back to Krasnik, but in the modern part of the city and the Polish students took us to the best kebab shop in the city. We spent the whole evening together before getting back to the hotel.

Wednesday 11th May - Third day

We visited the State Museum at Majdanek which was founded in November 1944 on the grounds of the former German concentration camp. There a guide explained the mission of the Museum to cultivate the memory and promote historical education about the German occupation in the Lublin region during World War II, particularly by means of commemorating the victims, preserving the relics and documenting the history of the concentration camp.



Then we went to the center of Lublin and we tried “pierogi”, a traditional Polish meal.

After that we took a boat ride on the Vistula river and visited the village, Kazimiers Dolny, where we had dinner.

At the end a bus took us back to the hotel, where we spent the evening together with all the students from the other nations.

Thursday 12th May - Fourth day

Today at 7 am a bus waiting for us in front of the hotel took us to Krakow. We enjoyed a guided tour with fantastic views, from the towering Wawel Castle to Florianska Street, the Market Square with the Town Hall Tower and St Mary's Basilica.

After the tour we had some free time to eat and buy some souvenirs and then we went back to Krasnik.

Once back, we went to the Polish students' homes, where they cooked traditional food and we enjoyed a lot.



Friday 13th May - Fifth day

We took a bus to school and, before visiting it, we relaxed in the park and along a lake next to the school.

After that we visited our partners' school and were made aware of the school system.

The Principal welcomed us and made a speech thanking all students and teachers for the precious experience. Then we were given the

Attendance Certificates and, as a souvenir, diaries with the logo of our Erasmus project "*Our European Literary Routes*".

We had lunch and some free time in the afternoon so that we could have enough time to get ready for the final dinner, that was fantastic and we all danced together.



Saturday 14th May - Sixth day

We left Krasnik and went to Krakow again to continue the sightseeing of the city. We had also some free time to have lunch and to buy some souvenirs. For dinner we went to a restaurant near the river and then we



saw the Father Bernatek's Bridge which was illuminated and therefore created a very suggestive atmosphere. Then we went back to the hotel in the centre of the city which was the same of the Greek students, so we spent some time with them.
